Key Geography Vocabulary:

Maps – a drawing of a particular area. They help us to know where places are located.

Physical features – these are natural. These include rivers, hills, forests, mountains, beaches, the weather, soil, vegetation, the sea and cliffs.

Human features – these are man-made. These include a village, city, farm, office, town, shop, house and harbour.

Country – this is a piece of land within a continent.

City – this is a place where people live closely together.

Capital city – this is a city where the government is located.

Chronological order – things that have happened in order.

Sequence of events – things that have happened in order

Timeline – a line to show the order in which events happened.

Past – a time before now

Present – the time right now
